It is illegal to buy, sell, grow or use cannabis anywhere in Australia

If you have a criminal record it can be

hard to get a job or travel overseas



It is illegal to buy, sell, grow or use cannabis in Australia, but the penalties are different in each state and territory In some states and territories, a person caught with a small amount for the first time may get a warning or small fine. They may have to go to counselling. You could also get a large fine and/or criminal record

A criminal record can make it harder to get a job and travel to some places like the USA
